



Regeneration & Renewal Awards shortlist announced

The shortlist for the Regeneration & Renewal Awards 2012 has been published, following the completion of the first round of the judging process.

Last month, the awards' panel of 45 expert judges met to consider 223 entries across 14 categories, from which they have selected 64 finalists.

The judging panel were split into teams of five and allocated award categories that matched their areas of expertise. Having studied each entry in turn and debated its merits, judges awarded each entry a score out of 100 based on the general criteria laid down for the awards as a whole, as well as category specific criteria.

Winners will be announced at a ceremony in November.

Chair of the judging panel Adam Branson commented: "On behalf of the judges and the team on Regeneration & Renewal and Planning, I would like to offer sincere congratulations to all involved in the short-listed projects."
