
We currently have a portfolio of 26 research projects that have cost over £3 million to commission. Several are investigating the cause and effect of childhood syndromes where the seizures, although relatively mild in themselves, have a huge impact on a child's ability to learn and remember things. Others are looking at areas such as examining the processes that occur in the brain to cause seizures, investigating why anti-epileptic drugs are not effective for some people and improving imaging techniques to maximise the outcomes of epilepsy surgery.

These projects are just some of the ways we are striving to make a difference to the lives of people with epilepsy. The research that Epilepsy Research UK funds is at the forefront of developments to control, and perhaps even cure, epilepsy and we look forward to greater advances being made in the near future.
