In the absence of my colleague Lucy Polson, I am writing to The Sandhu Charitable Foundation for your very generous donation of £5,000 to help Oxfam tackle the Ebola Crisis in West Africa. Thank you so much for your support, which comes at a time of great need in Sierra Leone and Liberia where Oxfam is working hard to prevent the spread of the virus.

Please accept this letter as a receipt of your donation.

As you will no doubt be aware, Ebola is currently incurable. On 30th September the UN declared the following 60 days to be critical in the fight against it. Your donation received early in this window of opportunity will help strengthen our ability to stop the spread of the disease.

It will enable our teams on the ground to support treatment centres with vital water supplies, provide protective clothing for health volunteers and distribute life-saving kits including soap and bleach. We are also using radio broadcasts and posters to tell people about Ebola and how to keep their families safe; particularly important in debunking some of the myths that are circulating about the disease, especially in remote areas.

Our ambition is very high – we need to reach four million people at risk of catching the disease. Thank you for responding to our appeal so generously and so quickly. Your continuing support to the families in crisis across the world is invaluable.
