EXCLUSIVE Impression of what the North Street

**The Sussex Express can exclusively reveal the first artist's impression of what the riverside in Lewes could look like if a developer is granted planning permission for the North Street Quarter.**

Santon North Street has applied to the South Downs National Park for planning permission for the ambitious development which includes 416 homes, public spaces, walkways and employment space.

It will create 475 full time equivalent jobs, while the construction of the development will generate another 100 full time jobs.

Residents will be able to

view the plans in detail on the national park's website and comment on the scheme.

The national park's planning committee will have the final say on the proposals.

It is estimated the scheme will go before the planning committee in the summer or autumn.

And construction could start on the site in early 2018.

Phase one would be completed by 2018, phase 2 would finish in summer 2019 and phase three would start in summer 2019.

The project would be complete by 2021.
