Your support will help restore the sight of even more children, like 14 year-old Rose (pictured in the striped top to the right) who's never learnt to read or write due to blinding cataract in both eyes since birth.

Through Sightsavers supporting the development of eye care services in the region of Malawi where Rose lived, she was able to be examined by one of our trained ophthalmic clinical officers, Rex, who confirmed she'd need a cataract operation to help her see again.

Rose was referred to the hospital where an operation by Dr Msukwa (above) led to her being able to see again.
