Thanks to your support, and the fantastic fundraising done by our 11 cyclists, the team have raised a whopping £33,000 for Build It International, which will provide valuable skills training for 33 young men and women in Zambia, meaning they have a better chance of employment and the opportunity of breaking the poverty cycle for themselves and their families.

I attach a photo of a young woman, Beauty Musonda who completed our construction skills training at our Centre for Excellence at Lusaka. Before she joined Build It she was stuck in a poverty cycle as she had to drop out of school at an early age due to financial issues. She is married with 4 young children and found herself unable to provide for her family. Having completed a 6 month training course and work placement with us on a community school where she lives things changed and she managed to build a new house for her family!

Beauty said "With the skills I had, I did not have to pay people to build my house, I used the skill I got Build It and created a five roomed house with the help of my cousin, but I was also supervising his work well. That is how we moved to our own home. In addition to building the house, I managed to get some farming equipment that helped me start farming since we already had a farm. From the money I received from farm products, I managed to develop a new business idea, and now I have bought some material, and I want to build a bar. I managed to get all those things because of the skill and support I got from Build It. If not for Build It, I would not care to build a house for my family, and I would not be supporting my family."

This is just one example of how lives have changed for so many young people thanks to the support of people like you.
